Creating a greater circular economy for labels – starting with label release liners in *your* backyard.

Once a label is removed, release liner plays no further role in the process and is typically discarded into the trash. Choosing and supporting release liner recycling may decrease your monthly trash cost while helping to divert material from landfills. The ability to recycle paper-based release liners, either as a dedicated recycling stream by itself or with your general paper recycling processes, depends on several factors, including volume, type, location, and logistics.

As part of CELAB's new release liner program, we have partnered with select wastepaper dealers in the Chicago area who are experienced and welcome recovered release liner in their recycling stream.
